The procedure

The filler is injected into the skin with a very fine needle and patients are injected with either a dental injection of local anaesthetic or a topical anaesthetic cream is applied to the skin before treatment. This is normally carried out in one appointment of 45-60mins.

How long will the results last?

The result from the treatment is immediate and will last about 6-10 months. The length of effect depends on a number of factors – including the area treated, your lifestyle and age, skin quality and amount of filler injected. Regular top-ups will mean that less material is needed at subsequent treatments in order to maintain the effect.
